This is a European-wide study of health care professional's current practices in relation to vascular access devices (VAD) for systemic anti-cancer therapy (SACT) across all age groups. It focuses on geographical location, choice of VAD, training and education, insertion and

management of complications. The goal of the study is to draw attention to any prospective areas that need more research in the area of current practices of VAD and SACT.

The study will be the **first interdisciplinary study across all VAD types and cancers.**
